

External Peer Team Review Report for the Academic Year 2021-22

Preamble:

An External Peer Team comprising of Principal Dr. Rajendra Shinde as the Chairperson, Principle Dr. Uma Shankar and Vice Principal Bipinchandra Wadekar as the members visited the Dombivli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's K.V. Pendharkar College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous), Dombivli on 10th September, 2022 between 10.00 am and 4.30 pm. Peer team members were received and welcomed by the IQAC Coordinator and NCC cadets of the college and then piloted to the Principal's office where there was a brief interaction with the Principal. After this the team broke up and individual members went to different venues/ rooms where relevant departmental presentations were made.

After a brief interlude for lunch the team then went on to have a meeting with the HODs of the different departments. This was also attended by the Principal and Vice Principals of the college. The three team members provided exhaustive and constructive comments based on what they had gathered/ seen from the earlier part of their visit. The meeting concluded with vote of thanks.

4. Syllabus revision up to 20 to 25% almost in all subjects seen.

6. Organises 'Entrepreneurial Expedition' for the Students to gain direct experience of Business and Commerce.
7. Certificate Course 'Basics of Investment Portfolio Management.
8. Removed topics which are non-relevant.
9. Introduction of the topic Industry 4.0 and Study of history of Industry revolution.
10. Question based on Case Study in Question Paper of Commerce Paper-I & II
11. 'Investment awareness exhibition' for students.
12. Commerce Readers' Club.

13. Certificate course in 'Sewage Treatment Plant Process' introduced by Department of Biotechnology for hands on training on analysis of treated sewage water.

Recommendations:

1. While Designing Syllabus local needs and requirements are to be identified. ✓
2. Question Paper Pattern needs to be designed properly. In internal evaluation methods more choices can be given to attract students. ✓
3. At least a few Journals of each subjects are to be purchased in library, specially of those subjects which have research departments.
4. Strengths, Weakness, Opportunities and Challenges (SWOC) of departments are to be reframed. ✓
5. Various soft skills including ICT training programmes for faculty should be organized.
6. Only routed activities are organised. Interdepartmental activities, inter & multi-disciplinary programs to be conducted at least once a year. ✓
7. Internet facility should be made available for the students in Library. A few additional classrooms can be enabled with ICT.
8. B.Com. (B&I) needs to be promoted aggressively. ✓
9. The workload for teachers should be as per the required UGC/ Government Norms only.
10. Teachers could be given some incentives for publishing papers in Scopus Indexed Journals.

11. National and International collaboration with Industries, academic and research institutes should be promoted. The college has a good practice of having international expert on most of the Syllabus framing Committees. Efforts should be made to have academic collaborations with those experts.
12. Use of Blooms Taxonomy in teaching and learning Pedagogy should be incorporated. ✓
13. Since number of students are from vernacular medium and language is seen as a weakness, the management should consider setting up of language lab.
14. Efforts to be put on Branding of the college, enrolment of students for regular as well as Self finance courses.
15. All 'demonstration' practicals should be replaced with hands on. This can be done by procuring multiple copies of instruments or replacing the practical with alternative experiments. •
16. English dept can conduct workshop on spoken English to Vernacular students and Psychology staff on mental wellness for Teaching & nonteaching staff.
17. Engage in more student centric activities. Organize State/ National / international Seminars or Conferences to showcase college this gives an opportunity to work as a team.
