Pre-Gathering

- A committee of Annual Gathering was formed headed by Ms. Neha Salagare and Mr.S.E.Kshirsagar vide notice dated 24.11.2022. In support of the event additional committees were also formed which are discipline committee headed by Mr. D.T.Pagare and Mr. Sandeep Bawaskar, Publicity Committee headed by Dr. Mrinal Kulkarni and Ms. Shreedula Mondkar, Stage and seating committee headed by Dr. Balasaheb Lahor and Mr. Brijesh Pandey.
- 05th December, 2022 1st meeting of the committee was scheduled and conducted.
 Meeting was chaired by Ms. Neha Salagare. She briefed all committee members about
 the event and reason behind the meeting. She was assisted by Co-chairperson Ms.
 Bhakti Pawaskar who discussed about different sub-committees to form and their role.
 Every sub-committee had an in-charge to check the progress and report.
- A proposal was made to present it before Sr. vice Principal K.P. Phalak and vice Principal Ashwini Bagkar. Proposal included the date venue and time of the event, duration, objectives, tentative performances, tentative budget, event outcome etc.
 Proposal was presented and finalised with some changes.
- Vice Principal Ashwini Bagkar and vice Principal B.T. Shirsath took a meeting discussing the vision behind annual gathering. The meeting finalised the theme of the event and also tentative type of performances.

- 20th December, 2022 an audition was conducted as notified vide notice dated 16th December, 2022 for selection of students for performing arts including dance singing and musical.
- 21st December, 2022 Chairman of Dombivli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal with I/C
 Principal and vice principal took a review meeting of junior college and degree college
 members of annual gathering. In this meeting it was resolved to conduct the gathering
 for two days by splitting the audience.
- 23rd December, 2022 vide notice Chairperson of annual gathering was replaced by Ms.
 Bhakti Pawaskar.
- 26th December, 2022 Chairperson of annual gathering conducted an online meeting of all committee members. The agenda of the meeting was to reallocate the subcommittee and work allocation. Meeting encompass suggestion and new ideas from senior members.
- January, 2023. In this all the subcommittee review was taken. Performances was reviewed and changes were made as necessary. A committee member Mr. Tejas Pednekar was replaced with Ms. Jyoti Dwivedi. Digital committee were asked to prepare the posters and banners. Public relation committee gave ideas on posters and prepared flashmob with students. Creative committee was preparing two models (Village and Institutions), title tile etc.
- 07th January 2023. Meeting was conducted in presence of I/C principal and all vice principals for the updates. Later meeting was chaired by chairman of DSPM. After deliberation it was concluded to concise the annual gathering to one day i.e. 1st February, 2023.
- 09th January 2023. Students of Degree College with public relation committee performed a flashmob after the inauguration of Annual sports day. This was to promote the upcoming event.
- Last week January 2023. All sub-committees were reviewed regularly and improvement were suggested wherever necessary. Inauguration Committee planned for Vignette (Maanpatra) which will be prepared by Dr. S.S.Mahajan for the Chief Guest. Hospitality committee distributed the entry pass for parents of prize winners and participants. They also distributed refreshment coupons to annual gathering committee members, discipline committee members, volunteers and participants. Prize distribution committee were ready with the name of winners, their certificates and

trophies as planned. Anchoring committee planned for the formal stage handling on mic. Digital committee was ready with all the banners, posters, volunteer's badges etc. Performance committee was ready with all the performance state ass suitable for the theme of the event. Creative committees were ready with models, rangoli design and standees. Stall committee allocated 10 stalls and undertaking was also collected from the stall owners. On 26th January after the republic day celebration a flashmob was performed to promote the event.

- With permission of the management and I/C principal performances were given a trial on the venue and duration was noted for tight scheduling. After the trial final program series was prepared compiling all the activities from welcome to winding up which spanned a duration of 03 hours and 45 minutes. A copy of the series were provided to the management, I/C principal, all vice principal, and discipline committee head.
- Discipline Committee prepared a structure through which discipline can be maintained during and after the event. Venue was distributed as blocks and all blocks were allotted to 2 teachers.
- Invitations to Chief Guest and Other Guest were also sent. Student council were also involved in the gathering to felicitate the guest.
- 31st January, 2023 I/C Principal, Vice principals, G.S. of student council, Annual gathering chairperson and co-chairpersons sat for a final briefing and arrangements.

On the day

On 01st February, 2023 student volunteers and teachers of creative committee reached D.S.P.M's Abasaheb Patwari Multi sports ground at 07.30 a.m. for decoration. Ms. Bhakti Pawaskar and Mr. Premkumar Nair were present to supervise. Ms. Shruti Bhosle took care of Rangoli while Ms. Anila Alakkal and Ms. Sandeedptha Ratheendran lent guidance to Village model installation. Ms. Prachi Jadhav took care of welcome path decoration. Vice Principal Ms. Ashwini Bagkar made a visit to the venue and guided on setup. Student volunteers also placed banners for promotions. Student volunteers completed model installation and rangoli by 10.30 a.m. and took snack break. Post break volunteers of rangoli were asked to leave and the remaining volunteers continued with stage decoration and institutional model installation. Mandap decorators started

their work by 10.30 a.m. with welcome gate decoration. They also worked on their part of stage decoration. LED display setup started installation by 12.30. Volunteers completed the decoration and left by 01.00 p.m. Later I/C Principal Prof. K.R. Jagdeo visited the venue for updates and instructed non-teaching staffs on seating arrangements. Ms. Bhakti Pawaskar and Mr. Premkumar Nair left the venue by 01.30 p.m. All the teaching and non-teaching staff members started arriving at the venue from 02.30 p.m. as instructed vide notice date 31.12.2023. Music system arrived by 03.00 p.m. and started installation. Stalls were installed two days prior and internal setup started by 03.00 p.m. Stalls were given to college students hence they came and started assembling their items for display and initiated preparation.

- By 04.15 p.m. all the arrangements were completed and the entire gathering was waiting for its Chief Guest's arrival. On 04.25 p.m. Chief Guest Honourable Shri Prabhakar Desai Chairman Dombivli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal arrived at the venue. Student welcomed pinned a badge and welcomed the Chief guests. 'Naad' a group of drumers (Dhol Tasha Pathak) started their musical march while Chief Guest is proceeding towards stage.
- Student Council headed by General Secretary Chandramani Kanaujiya took picture with the Chairman.
- The Chief Guest with other dignitaries proceeded towards stall inauguration. After inauguration every stalls were visited by guest. Post visiting and wishing them best the Chief Guest moved towards stage followed by Assitant to Chairman Ms. Reena Sonawane, I/C Principal Prof. K. R. Jagdeo, Sr. Vice Principal K. P. Phalak, Vice Principal Smruti Samant Vice principal B. T. Shirsath, Vice Principal Ms. Ashwini Bagkar Chairperson of Annual Gathering Ms. Bhakti Pawaskar and other teachers and students. In-charge of hospitality Dr. Sumita Kalekar greeted the Chief Guest and escorted to their seating.
- Dr. Mrinal Kulkarni took charge of the podium and started by greeting the chief guest, dignitaries and the audience. She gave a welcome note about the event and proceeded by asking Sr. vice Principal K.P.Phalak to felicitate the Chief Guest with a memento

and a bouquet. The speaker continued the felicitation by asking the student council general secretary to felicitate the guest Assistant to Chairman Ms. Reena Sonawane, and Headmistress of Sister Nivedita School Harshu Bellare. - From 05.10 p.m. performances started with a welcome dance. Performers showed glimpse of a classical form of dance "Bharatnatyam"
- From 05.15 p.m. state wise performance started with State of Maharashtra performed by students of Junior College. It touched the presence of lezim in Maharashtrian culture.
- 05.20 p.m. Students of Degree College presented a musical drama which was based on the script of how Dombivli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal was formed by its founder member and Current Chairman Shri P.R. Desai and his friends.
- 05.40 p.m. Students of Degree College showcased a wide range of cultural and ethnic traditions within the state of Maharashtra.
